Bonneville colours for UK

Year	Tank	Mudguards
1963 -	Alaskan White.	Alaskan White with Gold stripe and Black coach lines.
1964 -	Gold and Alaskan White.	Alaskan White with Gold stripe and Black coach lines.
1965 -	Pacific Blue and Silver.	Silver with Pacific Blue stripe and Gold coach lines.
1966 -	Grenadier Red and Alaskan White.	Alaskan White with Grenadier Red stripe and Gold coach lines.
1967 - start to mid	Aubergine and Gold.	Gold with Aubergine stripe and White coach lines.
1967- mid to end	Aubergine and Alaskan White.	Alaskan White with Aubergine stripe and Gold coach lines.
1968 -	Hi-Fi Scarlet and Silver.	Silver with Hi-Fi Scarlet stripe and Gold coach lines.
1969 -	Olympic Flame and Silver.	Silver with Olympic Flame stripe and White coach lines.
1970 -	Astral Red and Silver.	Astral Red with Silver stripe and Gold coach lines.

Trophy colours for UK

Year	Tank	Mudguards
1963 -	Regal Purple and Silver Sheen lined Gold	Silver Sheen with Regal Purple stripe and Gold coach lines.
1964 -	Hi-Fi Scarlet and Silver Sheen lined Gold	Silver Sheen with Hi-Fi Scarlet stripe and Gold coach lines.
1965 -	Burnished Gold and Alaskan White lined Baby Blue	Alaskan White with Burnished Gold stripe and Baby Blue coach lines.
1966 -	Pacific Blue and Alaskan White lined Gold	Alaskan White with Pacific Blue stripe and Gold coach lines.
1967 -	Mist Green and Alaskan White lined Gold	Mist Green with Alaskan White stripe and Gold coach lines.
1968 -	Riviera Blue and Silver Sheen lined Gold	Silver Sheen with Riviera Blue stripe and Gold coach lines.
1969 -	Trophy Red and Silver Sheen lined Gold	Trophy Red with Silver Sheen stripe and Gold coach lines.
1970 -	Spring Gold and Black centre stripe lined Gold	Spring Gold with Black stripe and Gold coach lines.

TR6C colours as Trophy colours except:

Year	Mudguards
1967 -	TR6C polished stainless steel
1968 -	TR6C polished stainless steel
1969 -	TR6C polished stainless steel
1970 -	TR6C polished stainless steel

Please Note: These are the approximate colour schemes for all the above models, but sometimes there were variations, depending on whether the machine was manufactured early or late in the year. You must check yourself by using your engine/frame number to verify and satisfy yourself that the colour scheme is correct for your bike.
